Supervised Care

Family and Parent with Child members may drop off any child on their membership aged 6-weeks to 12-years-old for our staff to watch while they use another part of our facility. We provide a safe space for children to grow, develop, socialize, and have fun! NOTE: Parents/guardians <u>MUST REMAIN IN THE BUILDING</u> while their children are in Supervised Care.

General Information

- Participants must possess an active Family or Parent and Child Membership.
- Each child must obtain a KidZone pass from the front desk before entering.
- Registration forms must be completed for each child within the KidZone.
- Children are expected to adhere to guidelines, including listening to staff, displaying kindness and respect, and maintaining cleanliness by tidying up after themselves.

Behavior Guidelines

- If rules are ignored, staff will notify parents and receive a warning email.
- Continued misbehavior may lead to a one-day suspension.
- After three suspensions in a year, further action may be taken.

Parent/Guardian Responsibilities

- Remember to sign in and out when dropping off or picking up your child.
- Registration forms must be filled out for each child upon their first facility use.
- Inside the KidZone, children are expected to follow staff instructions, demonstrate kindness, respect, and tidy up after themselves.

KidZone Time Limits

- Youth aged 6 weeks to 3 years old may stay with us for up to one hour.
- For children aged 3 to 8 years old, the maximum duration of care is extended to two hours.
- In situations where siblings belong to different age groups, they can stay up to two hours with parent/quardian checking in after 1 hour.

Health Guidelines

- Our staff members are also not authorized to administer medication or handle diaper changes.
- These policies are in place to prioritize safety and maintain a hygienic environment for all participants.
- If your child needs a snack, medicine, or diaper change while in our care, we will call the number you have listed as well as announce over the PA.
